5. What husband and wife have their portraits on display? (Mary Custiss Lee and Robert E. Lee)
6. Who was presented the white handkerchief in the frame on display? (Jefferson Davis)
7. Name three things on the portable field desk. (Varies)
8. What is also called a “Grapeshot Revolver?” (LeMat Revolver)
9. Name two instruments on display. (Varies)

10. Name three of the soldier's personal possessions on display. (varies)
11. On the print of "Prominent Union & Confederate Generals and Statesmen," who is #25 on the Union General's side? (McPherson)
12. Whose cigar is on display? (General Ulysses S. Grant)
13. Draw your favorite spur.
14. Name three alternate names for the Civil War. Hint: Found in a booklet in the exhibit.
15. Name something that changed after the Civil War.
